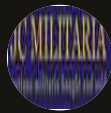

INERT DEACTIVATED WW2, 1943 Dated Unfired British 17pr (76.2 x 583R) Armour Piercing Capped /Trace (APC/T). Sn. 17162 - 17162

INERT DEACTIVATED This is a scarce unfired British 1943 dated 17pr (76.2 x 583R) Armour Piercing Capped /Trace (APC/T) round for the British 17pr tank gun, used in the Sherman Firefly, Archer converted from the Valentine tank, Achilles and the American M10 / M10A1 tanks. It was also used in 17 Pdr towed anti-tank gun. This armour piercing projectile was also used in the 77mm HV (High Velocity) gun in the Comet Tank. This projectile retains much of its original black finish with a white tip and a red band sandwiched between two white bands. This signifies full armour piercing to the diameter of the projectile. The projectile has two copper driving bands and is stamped above the bottom driving band APC17Pr IVT BS (Billet steel) AMC 8/43 (August 1943 date) & 77MMVIIIIT and LOT 508. The round is headstamped 19 PR I LOT 415, a crowfoot, DB/C 1943 (date) and CF (cordite full charge). The base of the cartridge case has traces of the stencil in black APC and the tracer symbol which was used to identify the type of ammunition in the ready to use storage of a tank or limber. The price includes UK delivery and no licence is required to possess this inert round in the UK if retained as part of a collection or display. Sn. 17162
